- Arrive 10-15 minutes early to check in and follow ushers' parking direction. Children stay with parents during worship.
- Bring your own chair, wear facemask, keep 6' social distance, and no food or drink allowed except for medical reasons.
- Report to deacon board if you develop COVID-19 symptoms within 14 days after attending in-person service.
