- 6. The Shine cell group will serve at the Dutchess Homeless Shelter on Thursday, 6/10.
- 7. As the COVID-19 pandemic situation improves rapidly in the last few weeks, Deacon Board decided to accelerate our church reopening plan. From 6/6, our church will return to normal for indoor services. Worship services will continue to be streamed on Zoom until the end of June during the transition. Due to technical difficulty and resource limitation, CM Sunday School and EM Sermon Echo can only be joined in church without Zoom service.

Other church gatherings such as cell group meetings, prayer meetings, and deacon board meetings, etc. remain on Zoom. Church plans to hold several outdoor activities during Summer and Fall time for fellowship.

To prepare for the reopening, the church has taken several steps to help protecting congregations.

- 1. Installed REME HALO In-Duct Air Purifier system
- 2. Installed clear plexiglass on the podium
- 3. Installed hand-free faucet and soap dispenser in toilet
- 4. Make hand sanitizer gel and wipes available in all common area
- 5. Sanitize frequent touch area in addition to regular weekly cleaning Pre-registration is required to join in-person worship at church. If there is a confirmed COVID-19 case among attendees, our church will use this registration data to notify those who joined the in-person service on that day. In addition, our church will stop in-person worship and return to Zoom for the next 2 weeks. Registration is open from Friday to 9 PM Saturday. No walk-ins are allowed. Please pre-register even if you are unsure about your Sunday worship schedule.

On the day of worship,

- 1. Arrive 5-10 minutes early to check-in
- 2. Use hand sanitizer at the entrance, wear facemask, maintain 6' social distance, avoid physical contact and refrain from eating or drinking indoor except for medical reasons
- 3. Refrain from touching the unnecessary area
- 4. Air conditioner will remain ON to keep air circulating
- 5. Special sitting arrangement in sanctuary
- 6. There will be no printed bulletin or use of bible and hymnal during services
- 7. No breakfast and lunch service

If you tested positive after joining in-person services, please notify Deacon Board immediately.

Deacon Board will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation and adjust as needed.

Church will hold a Q&A session after worship service on 5/30 to answer your additional questions.
